Reading- In Reader's Workshop, we are continuing our nonfiction unit.

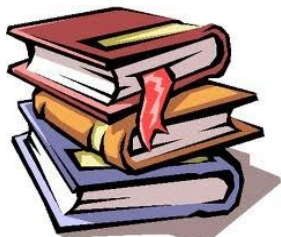
We are learning about text features and their importance.
