This month's curriculum:

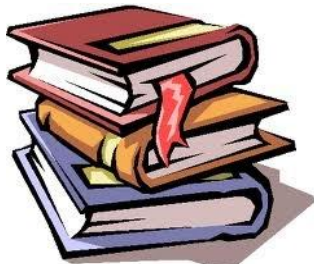
